Learning Objectives by Lesson



Lesson 1: Introduction to xAPI

- Define what xAPI is and how it differs from SCORM.
- Identify elements of an xAPI learning ecosystem (activity providers, LRS, LMS, etc.) and map your organization's current xAPI learning ecosystem.
- Identify the key components of an xAPI statement, including actor, verb, object, and context.

Lesson 2: Start with Questions

- Generate questions that can be answered using xAPI and the data needed to do so.
- Consider how learning evaluation frameworks can inform the questions you want to answer with data.
- Identify the different types of actions and events for which you can capture data.

Lesson 3: Use xAPI Profiles and Capture Data

- Use profiles to guide the design of your xAPI statements.
- Instrument a prototype learning experience to capture the needed data using standard data profiles.
- Use the xapi.ly statement builder to create custom xAPI statements.

Lesson 4: Collect and Analyze Your Data

- Connect your data source to an LRS endpoint.
- Collect, evaluate, and analyze the data generated.
- Communicate findings and results using data visualizations.

Lesson 5: Create a Plan for xAPI Adoption

- Determine where your organization is on the roadmap for xAPI adoption.
- Create a plan for using xAPI on a pilot or prototype within your own organization.
